Learn-to-Read

The grade 1-8 curriculum used by Zion Academy of America requires a student to be reading. To prepare the student for this curriculum, we offer a phonics course specifically designed for the non-reader or for the younger student who is elementary age and having reading difficulties. The course includes 35 letter sounds and 12 blend sounds basic to reading. This course is equivalent to a 1st grade reading program or advanced Kindergarten. At the completion of this course, the student will be academically equipped to continue in our other programs offered for elementary ages.

Graduation Policy

For a student to qualify for graduation and receive a diploma from Zion Academy of America, he/she must:

- Earn a minimum of **five** credits through Zion Academy of America Online Program option
- Complete all graduation requirements included on the student's customized Zion Academy of America Graduation Projection
- Fulfill all financial responsibilities to the satisfaction of the administration



GENERAL STUDIES *requires 22 credits*

This diploma is designed for a student who has a background of average achievement, as well as the one who needs more emphasis on the basic skills. It is recommended for the average student who has not yet settled on a specific career path or college. It is a distance learning program which is generally accepted at most colleges.

COLLEGE ADMISSION

National Association of Private School accredited school graduates are accepted at colleges and universities; however, some colleges may wish to validate the high school diploma before student admission is approved. Private Colleges and On-Line Private Colleges adhere to different policies for admission and may require other options for college admission.

Transfers Back to State Accredited Schools

The National Association of Private Schools is an independent accreditation agency nonaffiliated with any state, secular or regional accreditation or accrediting agencies. Students returning to a state accredited public school may be asked to be tested by the receiving public school to determine if he/she should be placed in the desired grade level, or if certain credits may be transferred to the receiving school. Public Schools are not required to accept credits from schools not accredited by the state or regional accrediting agencies.

Diagnostic Placement Test

Upon enrollment, each student is evaluated academically using a Diagnostic Placement Test (DPT) to measure the student's academic abilities and to determine skill and concept mastery in the areas of Math, English, Reading, and Spelling. The DPT is one of our educational services and helps to create a customized assignment.

For the high school student, the complete DPT gives insight to the academic staff whether the student is best suited for the General Studies or one of the College Preparatory courses of study.



Accreditation

Zion Academy of America is ACCREDITED by the National Association of Private Schools (NAPS).

NAPS is "an independent educational agency founded for the purpose of recognizing educational excellence in the private and non-traditional educational environment." It is a national organization headquartered in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

According to the website for the National Association of Private Schools,

- Accreditation reflects a school's "trustworthiness in the process of providing a quality educational program."
- Schools accredited by NAPS "have demonstrated a history of providing their students with a quality educational program . . . [that] seeks to meet or exceed state and national traditional educational guidelines in their pre-school through high school educational programs."
- Schools accredited by NAPS "are concerned about both the mastery of basic academic skills and the character development of each child in their school."



NAPS explain the meaning of "accreditation" this way:

"The word accredit is an interesting word related to the same root word as credible, or believable. An accredited institution, therefore, is one that can be believed. It has earned the approval of those who know it. Accreditation means,

"This institution is fulfilling its stated purposed with integrity and excellence."

The process of accreditation involves a careful scrutiny and approval of a school's qualifications by other professionals. Just as "surgeons are approved by other surgeons [and] lawyers are approved by other lawyers, educators [should be approved] by other educators." The NAPS evaluation is conducted by peers of the private school seeking accreditation who understand the "basic philosophy and uniqueness of an individual school" such as Zion Academy of America.

According to NAPS, "Quality private educational institutions and their staff[s] deserve the merited recognition of their peers." **The accreditation of Zion Academy of America gives parents the assurance of an educational program that has not only stood the test of time but has provided a consistent level of excellence.**

Parents can also be confident that the curriculum used by Zion Academy of America has been CERTIFIED by the National Association of Private Schools' Curriculum Evaluation Committee.

The Whole Family Story

The journey for the founder of Zion Academy of America (ZAA) from a local homeschooling to a K-12 distance learning program nationwide began in the early 1980s when she noticed the academics of the American school were declining, and the education of her own children was suffering. There were very few options available in those days, and private schools were so expensive. After much searching, she finally found a private church school that she and her husband could afford for her two children.



At the time, her girls were in the 2nd and 6th grades. At the end of their school year, she withdrew them from the local public school and enrolled them in a private church school. Homeschooling was rare and virtually unknown in the early 1980s, and "homeschool" was not yet a household word.

During the following year, the Pastor of the church decided to close the school. This meant she needed to look again for a school for her children. She knew that she could not send her girls back to public school. So, she did something that was bold and controversial at the time, which was to school her own children at home. This was when homeschooling was thought to be illegal. Now, it is known to be legal in all states in America, although each state has unique guidelines.

Zion Academy of America's founder is a pioneer in homeschooling.

It was just a matter of time when families started going to her and asking a lot of questions and wanting her to teach them how to do the same for their children. It was then that she saw the need to begin an accredited academy for homeschooling, to make it easy for these children to receive high school diplomas and to enter colleges and universities.

Zion Academy of America was officially birthed in the 1980s. Its humble beginnings started in Fort Worth, Texas, and operated locally for more than 10 years. It is now a nationally recognized, accredited distance learning school which has enrolled thousands over the years and graduated hundreds of students, many going on to colleges and universities throughout the country. ZAA operated near Seattle, Washington for 20 years and is now back home in Texas. ZAA is serving families across America and beyond its borders.

The daughters completed the College Preparatory Honors courses of study offered by ZAA and graduated with honors from the accredited diploma program. The older daughter became a corporate executive assistant and later married and gave birth to two daughters. She now works in ZAA as the Director of Operations. The younger daughter married a minister, and they had four children. She is the Director of Admissions for ZAA. All the founder's grandchildren are either enrolled or have graduated from ZAA.
